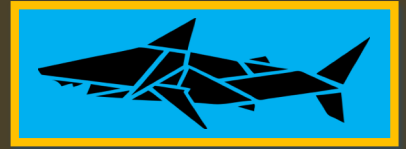

 - IXL, Readworks, Raz-Kids

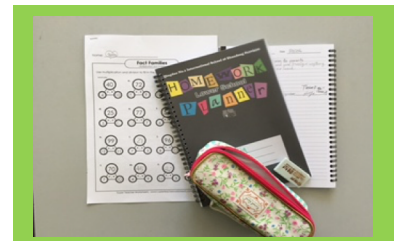
