How Plants Changed the World



Grade 4 is working on their Innovation Day projects by brainstorming solutions to the problems they have identified that affect plants and natural resources. They will be making a plan for their solution and start gathering materials to make their design come to life. Moreover, the students are exploring plant structures in experiments to observe how they support plants in their survival and growth.

In Math, the students are demonstrating their learning about factors and multiples by creating an opinion project that explains why they would rather be a Factor Ninja or Multiple Monster.

In Literacy, students are writing introductions for their opinion essays and finding supporting evidence for their opinions.
